

Important Information

For Mobile Food Vendors in Lincoln Charter Township

- NO mobile food vendor can operate within Lincoln Charter Township until a mobile food vendor permit is issued by Lincoln Charter Township.
- Permits are valid for dates specified and approved.

OPERATING REQUIREMENTS

- Lincoln Charter Township mobile food vendor permit must be prominently displayed while operating in the Township.
- Mobile food vehicle or cart cannot impede visibility of the flow of vehicle, pedestrian or bicycle traffic.
- Hours of operation are limited to 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- Mobile food vendor vehicles or carts must:
 - Have the name of the operating vendor.
 - Get approval from the township to operate within the township in designated areas.
 - Have a state license plate attached and have fully functioning brakes, lights, tires, horn, muffler, a rear vision mirror and windshield wiper.
 - Have sufficient garbage cans for themselves and customers.
 - Have available a copy of the required county health department permits.
- Mobile food vendor workers cannot:
 - Leave vending unit unattended on a public street or parking lot between 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
 - Drink alcohol beverages while on duty.
 - Shout or call out to prospective customers or disturb the peace in any way.
 - Leave waste of any kind.
 - Use sound amplifying equipment, lights or noisemakers.
 - Serve food on the driving side lane of the mobile food vehicle or cart.

VIOLATIONS

Lincoln Charter Township may revoke or suspend a permit if the vendor does not meet the requirements of this ordinance or those of state, federal or local laws. The applicant may appeal the permit revocation or suspension in writing.
