Plans must be submitted with an application or Plan Examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below.

Plans are not required for the following:

1. One - and two-family dwellings containing not more than 3,500 square feet of building area.
2. Alterations and repair work determined by the plumbing official to be of a minor nature.
3. Buildings with a required plumbing fixture count less than 12.
4. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00.

\*If work being performed is described above, check box below "Plans not Required."\*

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervision of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

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### VI. Homeowner Affidavit

<b>Item #2, Mobile Home Unit Site:</b> When item is used for sewer excavations in a new park, the permit application should include the application fee, the number of unit sties and a final inspection. When setting a mobile home in a park, or a mobile or modular home on private property, a permit should include the application fee, a sewer or building drain, a water service or water distribution pipe and a final inspection.

<b>Item #25, Domestic Water Treatment and Filtering Equipment:</b> A license is not required for the installation of domestic water treatment and filtering equipment that requires modification to an existing cold water distribution supply and associated water piping in buildings if a permit is secured, required inspections performed and the installation complies with the applicable code. If the enforcing agency determines a violation exists, it shall be corrected by the responsible installer. The permit application shall include the application fee, the number of water treatment devices recorded in item #25 and the appropriate water distribution pipe (system) size fee.

VIII. Instruction for Completing Application

General: Plumbing work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with Lincoln Charter Township. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Plumbing Code. No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected. The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. The Inspector will need the job location and permit number.

<p>Expiration of Permit: A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days after the time of commencing the work. <b>A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTION ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED. THE CHARGE TO RE-OPEN A CLOSED PERMIT IS \$75.00.</b></p>
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
